## **VENDOR RULES**

1. Vendors will be provided with 10x10 space/6 ft table/2 chairs. No electricity.
2. Vendors can bring their own canopy or FACO will provide an additional fee of \$100. The deadline to order canopy from FACO is on **June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025**.
3. Vendors will be assigned their spot on a first come, first served basis in order of the payment received. The table will be assigned and marked with the number and name of vendor. Booth assignments will be strictly followed. FACO has the right to decline application if no space is available. All exhibitors must pay in full upon signing of application. The deadline for payment is on May **30<sup>th</sup>**. Any booths not paid in full will forfeit their space without a refund. Cancellations made after **June 12<sup>th</sup>** will not be refunded.
4. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN DUE TO BAD WEATHER OR UNFORSEEN EVENTS OUT OF CONTROL OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE.**
5. **SET-UP: Vendors are allowed to bring only one vehicle and should load and unload at designated loading/unloading area. Set-up time starts at 9:00 AM. All booths should be ready by 11:00.**
6. **BREAKDOWN: Vendors may NOT tear down their booths prior to 6:00 pm, unless an official announcement is made and confirmed that the program has finished.**
7. **CLEANUP: Vendors are responsible for cleaning up their areas and responsible for their own trash disposal within their booth. Vendors shall reimburse FACO for any cleaning or repair costs due to vendor activities.**
8. **FOOD VENDORS are responsible for getting their temporary permit to sell food for the event. FACO MUST HAVE THE TEMPORARY PERMIT BY/ON MAY 29<sup>th</sup>.** Any questions about food handling and safety are to be directed to County of SD Dept. of Environmental Health Food & Housing Div., Temp. Events, [www.sandiegocounty.gov/content/sdc/deh/fhd/food/tempevents.html](http://www.sandiegocounty.gov/content/sdc/deh/fhd/food/tempevents.html) or (858) 505-6809. This includes any questions about cooking, fuel, and waste. It is the entire responsibility of the vendor to make sure no waste that is a hazard or cleaning expense, such as grease, is left on the plaza or surrounding area, including planters, trash bins or sewers.
9. **Food vendors MUST place a tarp down to cover the entire booth to avoid spills to concrete ground.**
10. **NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION** should provide proof of their non-profit status.
11. Vendors will confine all activities to the boundaries of the booth space.
12. Vendors are not allowed to contract/lease any space to a second party without written permission from the organizer.
13. No alcoholic drinks, tobacco products, prohibited drugs and/or its paraphernalia can be sold or sampled.
14. Vendors are not allowed to use any loudspeaker, megaphones, amplifiers, or any type of public address system. FACO will not be responsible for any loss or damage to the vendor's properties.
15. **I have read and shall comply with all the above rules and regulations of the FACO Filipino Cultural Celebration organizer.**
